



RANA, the R-Adhikarya "Niche" Award, is a token of appreciation and recognition for smart, innovative, and competitive young students who wish to further pursue their dreams of learning, exploring and applying disruptive ideas, and "niche" innovative thinking in their studies and future careers.

RANA is a competitive Award offered annually at three (3) world-class US educational institutions,

- The East-West Center (EWC) in Honolulu, Hawaii,
- Stanford University in Stanford, California, and
- Cornell University in Ithaca, New York (at the Department of Global Development),

that will help encourage, motivate, and increase the confidence of promising students to explore unique and unusual - as opposed to "more-of-the-same" competencies and solutions in their future careers.

It is to reward those who dare to think differently and are interested in studying and solving important contemporary problems and/or future societal **needs/wants** not currently being considered or significantly addressed by others. It supports young visionaries to develop a **"Growth Mindset"**.



## The Awards

- **1. The East-West Center (EWC)**Offered annually starting in 2020, either as:
  - ☐ Award-1a + EWC Graduate Degree Fellowship Total Value US\$103,000 Coverage: US\$10,000 in cash, housing, books,

insurance, and stipends (valued at US\$26,000 total for two years), plus Tuition Fees at the University of Hawaii (UH) for 2 years (valued at US\$67,000), or

□ Award-1b + EWC Foundation Scholarship Total Value US\$56,000 Coverage: US\$10,000 each in cash, plus a reduction in Tuition Fees at the University of Hawaii (UH) for 2 years (valued at US\$36,000).

An opportunity for a short-term INTERNSHIP at the Office of the Minority Leader Emeritus, State of Hawaii's Legislature, Honolulu, can be arranged based on mutual agreement.

2. Awards at Stanford and Cornell Universities offered a minimum of US\$10,000 plus possible financial aid from each University.

## **Eligibility**

- 1. Must be admitted to a graduate degree program at the University of Hawaii (UH) and be selected for the EWC's Graduate Degree Fellowship or EWC's Foundation Scholarship. For Stanford and Cornell Universities: See RANA Prospectus.
- 2. Students from Indonesia or any other students whose proposed study/research is significantly relevant to Indonesia may apply. Those from ASEAN and Legal Residents of Hawaii will be given
- 3. Participate in the RANA Competition, the winner of which will be selected by an International **Selection Committee** (independent from the Award Donor).



## **How to Apply**

- 1. Complete both applications for (a) the EWC's **Graduate Degree Fellowship (GDF)** and (b) the University of Hawaii's graduate school by December 1 each year.
- 2. Complete the application for RANA by February 28 each year.
- 3. See RANA Prospectus for Stanford and Cornell Universities' Applications, and Award Recipients at these two universities will be selected by the institutions themselves.
